Frequently Asked Questions about the sliding scale:

- Q. If I enrol in full time General English for 5 weeks initially and then extend my course for 10 weeks, which rate will I pay?**
- A.** If you extend, you will receive the rate applicable to the total duration of your enrolment, for example:
Initial enrolment: 5 weeks @ \$305
Extension: 10 weeks @ \$295 (ie: the rate for 15 weeks)
Total duration: 15 weeks
- Q. I enrol for 40 weeks of General English @ \$285 per week. After 30 weeks of General English I transfer to the EAP course for 14 weeks. How much extra do I pay?**
- A.** You will have \$2,850 credit for the remaining 10 weeks of GE. You need to pay the difference between \$2,850 and the EAP semester fee of \$3,990 so you will pay \$1,140 extra.

ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES (EAP)

English for Academic Purposes (EAP) is designed for students who plan to go on to University studies. EAP has 3 levels. For entry to EAP students must take the EAP pre-entry examination. As a guide, entry requirements are: Level 1 - IELTS 5.0; Level 2 - IELTS 5.5; Level 3 - IELTS 6.0.

Students will improve their English and academic study skills to ensure that they are well prepared for University.
